Senior resident Physician and Head of the multidisciplinary Pain Centre, department of Anesthesiology at the University of Munich.

Vice-president DÄGfA and head of educational centre. Dr Irnich is a renowned expert of acupuncture research and invited lecturer on pain therapy, acupuncture and CAM at Universities worldwide. He is member of the faculty at different institutions (e.g. Structural Acupuncture Course, Harvard Medical School), (co-)editor of different scientific journals and member of international research groups.

Dr Irnich is laureate of 11 national and international awards in acupuncture and TCM.

Since 1996 he published more than 75 scientific papers as principal author or co-author. The latest come out in 2013 is the English version of his successful "Leitfaden Triggerpunkte" by Elsevier. It is a comprehensive manual on trigger points called: "Myofascial Trigger Points: Comprehensive Diagnosis and Treatment" by Churchill Livingstone.
